Weekdays:

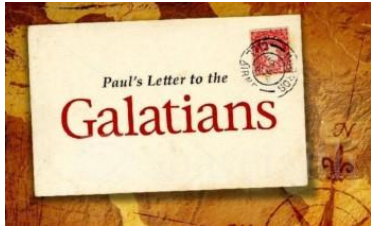
Youth Group: grades 5-10 meet Thursdays, 3:30-4:30pm.

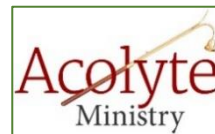

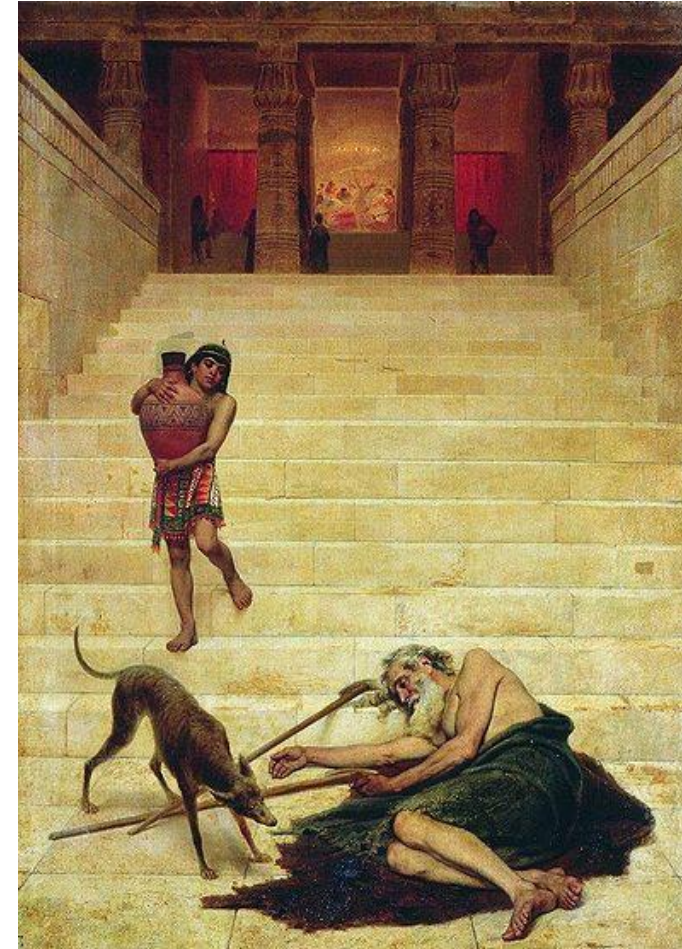
